Zachary Metsa opened the scoring 3:16 into the middle frame, scoring his fourth goal of the season and third coming against Cleveland. The second-year pro leads all Rochester defensemen in scoring with 33 points (4+29) while his 29 assists are tied for the most in the AHL amongst all blueliners.

Brett Murray doubled Rochester's lead with his 22nd goal of the season. Murray's goal puts him one shy of tying his career-best 23goal season from the 2022-23 AHL campaign. The sixth-year Amerk is second on Rochester with 38 points (22+16) this season and is five goals from 100 as an Amerk. Additionally, he needs just two more goals to tie Steve Langdon (97) for 20th all-time in franchise history.

Noah Ostlund completed the scoring during the second period by netting his sixth goal of the season, then tallied his second of the night on an empty netter late in the third. The goals give the rookie forward three in as many games. Dating back to Jan. 10, Ostlund has amassed 13 points (5+8) over his last 14 games.

Devon Levi's 26-save shutout was his fourth of the season and second this month. It was also his fifth win over his last seven games. He becomes the fifth AHL goaltender to record four shutouts this season, three of which have come on home ice.

Rochester is now second in the AHL with 171 goals scored

Tonight's win vaulted the Amerks to first place overall in the American Hockey League with 66 points through their first 49 games.
