TODAY'S GAME

The Rochester Americans conclude their 2019 preseason schedule today as they face the Toronto Marlies at Ray Twinney Complex in Newmarket, Ontario. The 4:00 p.m. matchup will mark the second meeting between the two teams in the last two days and will serve as the final tune-up for both teams prior to the regular season.

HEAD-TO-HEAD FOR 2019-20

Following this weekend's exhibition contests with Toronto, the Amerks and Marlies will face-off a total of six times during the 2019-20 season. The first meeting will occur at The Blue Cross Arena on Friday, Nov. 29 before the Amerks make their first trip north of the border to Coca-Cola Coliseum on Saturday, Jan. 4. The North Division rivals will then meet on Tuesday, March 17 at Scotiabank Arena in Toronto before closing out the season series on Wednesday, March 25 back in the Flower City.

HEAD-TO-HEAD RESULTS VERSUS TORONTO

- After registering a pair of wins to open the season series with the Marlies during the 2018-19 slate, the Amerks finished with a 5-1-0-0 record, including a perfect 3-0-0-0 on the road.
- During each of the six games between Rochester and Toronto last season, the winning team had scored five goals, including the Amerks' 5-4 come-from-behind overtime victory to close out the head-to-head matchup on March 24.
- In 13 of the last 18 meetings dating back to the 2016-17 season, the team that scored first has gone on to come away with the victory.

RECAPPING THE PRESEASON THROUGH TWO GAMES

After dropping the first game of the preseason by a 4-1 score to the Syracuse Crunch on Thursday at the Gene Polisseni Center on the campus of R.I.T., the Amerks responded Friday night with a 3-2 victory in the front-end of the home-and-home series with the Marlies. Defensemen **Justin Baudry** (1+1) and **Tobie Bisson** (0+2) led all Rochester skaters with two points through both matchups.
